Senior Management Action Required

If a candidate only marginally meets the prescribed standards, please follow the instructions on page three of the syllabus. A senior management signature is required on all applications.

Application Submission Deadline

The deadline for submission of applications is **Thursday, June 17, 2010**. While the Class of 2012 will be capped at sixty students, the minimum number of students needed to form the Class of 2012 is forty. Acceptance letters will be sent to all students (and their CEO) in early July.

Please see page three of the syllabus for a full description of the fees associated with attendance. Tuition statements will be mailed in early August to each sponsoring bank. There have been no changes in tuition rates for the upcoming year.
